## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to honorary license plates for certain disabled veterans.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 504.202, Transportation
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 504.202. VETERANS WITH CERTAIN DISABILITIES.
- 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,
- 8 is amended by adding Section 504.2021 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 504.2021. HONORARY LICENSE PLATES FOR VETERANS WITH
- 10 DISABILITIES. (a) The department shall issue specialty license
- 11 plates for a veteran of the United States Armed Forces who has
- 12 <u>suffered</u>, as a result of military service, a service-connected
- 13 disability that does not meet the requirements of Section
- 14 504.202(b)(1).
- 15 (b) License plates issued under this section must include
- 16 the words "Disabled Veteran" and "U.S. Armed Forces" and must be
- 17 clearly distinguishable from license plates issued under Section
- 18 504.202.
- 19 (c) A person entitled to specialty license plates under this
- 20 section may register, for the person's own use, one vehicle without
- 21 payment of any fee other than the fee for the license plates under
- 22 <u>Subsection (d).</u> Registration under this section is valid for one
- 23 year.
- 24 (d) The fee for the first set of license plates is \$3. There

- 1 is no fee for each additional set of license plates. If a license
- 2 plate is lost, stolen, or mutilated, on payment of a \$1 fee the
- 3 department shall issue a set of replacement plates.
- 4 (e) Eligibility to receive a license plate under this
- 5 section does not qualify a person to receive a disabled parking
- 6 placard under Section 681.004 unless the person otherwise qualifies
- 7 for a placard under that section.
- 8 <u>(f) A person entitled to license plates under this section</u>
- 9 may elect to receive license plates issued under Chapter 502 under
- 10 the same conditions for the issuance of license plates under this
- 11 section.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
