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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 111, Tax Code, is 6 repealed.

7 SECTION 2. The repeal of Subchapter F, Chapter 111, Tax Code, by this Act does not affect an eligible person's right to 8 claim a refund of state sales and use and state franchise taxes that 9 was established under Section 111.301, Tax Code, in relation to 10 11 taxes paid before the effective date of this Act in a calendar year 12 for which the person paid ad valorem taxes to a school district as provided by Section 111.301, Tax Code, before the effective date of 13 14 this Act. An eligible person's right to claim a refund of state sales and use and state franchise taxes that was established under 15 Section 111.301, Tax Code, in relation to taxes paid before the 16 effective date of this Act in a calendar year for which the person 17 paid ad valorem taxes to a school district as provided by Section 18 111.301, Tax Code, before the effective date of this Act is governed 19 20 by the law in effect on the date the right to claim the refund was 21 established, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22 purpose.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
