A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to allowing the governor, and the lieutenant governor or
- 3 another person when acting as governor, to retain executive
- 4 authority while traveling within the contiguous 48 states of the
- 5 continental United States.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 401.022, Government Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:

- 9 Sec. 401.022. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "unavailable"
- 10 means, with respect to the governor or a person authorized to act as
- 11 governor under the Texas Constitution or this subchapter:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> not able to exercise the powers and discharge the
- 13 duties of the office of governor for any reason specified in the
- 14 Texas Constitution;
- 15 (2) being physically located outside the territorial
- 16 boundaries of the contiguous 48 states of the continental United
- 17 States;
- 18 (3) being physically located outside the state but
- 19 <u>inside the territorial boundaries of the contiguous 48 states of</u>
- 20 the continental United States if the governor or person authorized
- 21 to act as governor gives notice that the governor or person
- 22 <u>authorized to act as governor will not rely on electronic</u>
- 23 communication while absent from the state; or
- 24 (4) being physically located outside this state for

- 1 more than 14 consecutive days.
- 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 401, Government Code, is
- 3 amended by adding Section 401.0225 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 401.0225. NOTICE OF UNAVAILABILITY. The governor or a
- 5 person authorized to act as governor shall reasonably notify the
- 6 next person in the line of succession under the Texas Constitution
- 7 or this subchapter when the governor or person authorized to act as
- 8 governor will become unavailable as described by Section
- 9 401.022(2), (3), or (4).
- SECTION 3. Section 401.025, Government Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 401.025. EXCEPTION. The [president pro tempore of the
- 13 senate or] speaker of the house of representatives may act as
- 14 governor under this subchapter only if the person holds that office
- 15 when the governor and lieutenant governor first become unavailable.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on the date on which the
- 17 constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 18 Session, 2011, providing that the governor, and the lieutenant
- 19 governor when acting as governor, retain executive authority unless
- 20 unavailable as provided by law is approved by the voters. If that
- 21 amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
