- 7 SECTION 1. Section 401.022, Government Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 401.022. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "unavailable"
- 10 means, with respect to the governor or a person acting as governor
- 11 under the Texas Constitution or this subchapter:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> not able to exercise the powers and discharge the
- 13 duties of the office of governor for any reason specified in the
- 14 Texas Constitution; or
- 15 (2) being physically located outside the territorial
- 16 boundaries of the contiguous 48 states of the continental United
- 17 States.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 401.025, Government Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- Sec. 401.025. EXCEPTION. The [president pro tempore of the
- 21 senate or speaker of the house of representatives may act as
- 22 governor under this subchapter only if the person holds that office
- 23 when the governor and lieutenant governor first become unavailable.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the date that the

- 1 constitutional amendment proposed by the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 2 Session, 2011, providing that the governor, and the lieutenant
- 3 governor when acting as governor, retain executive authority unless
- 4 unavailable as provided by law is approved by the voters. If that
- 5 amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
