- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Parks and Wildlife
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 12.012 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.012. RECREATIONAL WATER SAFETY VIDEO. (a) The
- 8 department shall produce a video suitable for use with high school
- 9 students on recreational water safety. The video must include
- 10 instruction on safe participation in recreational activities in,
- on, or around the lakes, rivers, and coastal waters of this state.
- 12 (b) The department shall notify the Texas Education Agency
- 13 <u>in writing when the recreational water safety video is available</u>
- 14 for the agency's use.

- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 29.9021 to read as follows:
- Sec. 29.9021. WATER SAFETY EDUCATION. The agency by rule
- 18 shall incorporate a curriculum module on recreational water safety
- 19 into driver education instruction using the video on recreational
- 20 water safety produced under Section 12.012, Parks and Wildlife
- 21 Code, when the agency is notified that the video is available.
- 22 SECTION 3. The Parks and Wildlife Department shall produce
- 23 the recreational water safety video described by Section 12.012,
- 24 Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act, as soon as production

- 1 costs can be paid from money identified as available for that
- 2 purpose in the department's operating budget.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
