- 4 SECTION 1. Section 151.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 151.001. REFERRAL BY AGREEMENT. On agreement of the
- 7 parties, in civil [or family] law matters pending in a district
- 8 court, statutory probate court, or statutory county court, the
- 9 judge in whose court the case is pending shall [may] order referral
- 10 of the case as provided by this chapter and shall stay proceedings
- 11 in the judge's court pending the outcome of the trial. Any or all
- 12 of the issues in the cases, whether an issue of fact or law, may be
- 13 referred.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 151.001, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 15 Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an agreement to refer
- 16 a case to a special judge made on or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. An agreement made to refer a case to a special judge made
- 18 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 19 effect at the time the agreement was made, and that law is continued
- 20 in effect for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
