Property Code, as amended by this Act, apply only to a condemnation in which the final offer is made by a governmental entity on or after the effective date of this Act. A condemnation in which the final offer is made before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offer was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
