- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 28.004(m), Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (m) In addition to performing other duties, the local school
- 11 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at
- 12 least annually, a written report that includes:
- 13 (1) any council recommendation concerning the school
- 14 district's health education curriculum and instruction or related
- 15 matters that the council has not previously submitted to the board;
- 16 (2) any suggested modification to a council
- 17 recommendation previously submitted to the board; [and]
- 18 (3) a detailed explanation of the council's activities
- 19 during the period between the date of the current report and the
- 20 date of the last prior written report; and
- 21 (4) for each district elementary, middle, or junior
- 22 high school campus, a detailed explanation of the extent and manner
- 23 of the campus's compliance with the requirement under Section
- 24 11.253(d)(10) for the campus to set, in the campus improvement

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- 1 plan, goals and objectives for the coordinated health program at
- 2 the campus.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
