A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the sale or lease of property by certain municipalities

- 3 owning land near the shoreline of certain lakes.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 272.001(h), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) A municipality having a population of 825,000 [575,000]
- 8 or less and owning land within 5,000 feet of where the shoreline of
- 9 a lake would be if the lake were filled to its storage capacity may,
- 10 without notice or the solicitation of bids, sell the land to the
- 11 person leasing the land for the fair market value of the land as
- 12 determined by a certified appraiser. While land described by this
- 13 subsection is under lease, the municipality owning the land may not
- 14 sell the land to any person other than the person leasing the land.
- 15 To protect the public health, safety, or welfare and to ensure an
- 16 adequate municipal water supply, property sold by the municipality
- 17 under this subsection is not eligible for and the owner is not
- 18 entitled to the exemption provided by Section 11.142(a), Water
- 19 Code. The instrument conveying property under this subsection must
- 20 include a provision stating that the exemption does not apply to the
- 21 conveyance. In this subsection, "lake" means an inland body of
- 22 standing water, including a reservoir formed by impounding the
- 23 water of a river or creek but not including an impoundment of salt
- 24 water or brackish water, that has a storage capacity of more than

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- 1 10,000 acre-feet.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
