## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the date for a political party's precinct conventions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 174.022(a), (b), and (c), Election
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The precinct conventions shall be held in the regular
- 7 <u>county election precincts on:</u>
- 8 <u>(1)</u> general primary election day; or
- 9 (2) a date determined by the county executive
- 10 committee that occurs not later than the fifth day after the date of
- 11 the general primary election [in the regular county election
- 12 precincts].
- (b) Consistent with Subsection (c), not [Not] later than the
- 14 date of the regular drawing for position on the general primary
- 15 election ballot, the county executive committee shall set the hour
- 16 and place for convening each precinct convention for the precincts
- 17 served by the committee. If the county executive committee fails to
- 18 do so, the county chair shall set, consistent with Subsection (c),
- 19 the hour and place.
- 20 (c) If the precinct conventions are held on general primary
- 21 <u>election day</u>, the [The] hour set for convening the conventions may
- 22 not be earlier than 7 p.m. or later than 9 p.m., but a
- 23 [Notwithstanding the hour set for convening, the] convention may
- 24 not convene until the last voter has voted at the precinct polling

- 1 place. If the precinct conventions are held on a day other than
- 2 general primary election day, the county executive committee shall
- 3 set the hour for convening or a time frame in which the conventions

- 5 SECTION 2. Section 174.023, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 174.023. NOTICE OF <u>DATE</u>, HOUR, AND PLACE. (a) The
- 8 county chair shall post a notice of the <u>date</u>, hour, and place for
- 9 convening each precinct convention on the bulletin board used for
- 10 posting notice of meetings of the commissioners court. The notice
- 11 must remain posted continuously for the 10 days immediately
- 12 preceding the date of the convention.
- 13 (b) Not later than the 10th day before the date of the
- 14 precinct conventions, the county chair shall deliver to the county
- 15 clerk written notice of the <u>date</u>, hour, and place for convening each
- 16 precinct convention.
- 17 (c) If the county chair fails to post or deliver notice in
- 18 accordance with this section, another member of the county
- 19 executive committee may post or deliver the notice.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
