Sec. 34.0021. AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT BY PARENT IN CHILD

PROTECTIVE SERVICES CASE; TERMINATION. (a) A parent may enter into

an authorization agreement with a relative or other person with

whom a child is placed under a parental child safety placement

agreement approved by the Department of Family and Protective

Services to allow the person to perform the acts described by

H.B. No. 848

Section 34.002(a) with regard to the child: 1 2 (1) during an investigation of abuse or neglect; or (2) while the department is providing services to the 3 4 parent. 5 (b) An authorization agreement under Subsection (a) 6 terminates if: 7 (1) the department terminates the parental child 8 safety agreement; or (2) the parental child safety agreement expires. 9

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
