- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 707.017, Transportation Code, as amended
- 7 by Chapters 266 (H.B. 2530), 542 (S.B. 1617), and 933 (H.B. 3097),
- 8 Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, is reenacted
- 9 and amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 707.017. REGISTRATION AFTER CIVIL PENALTY IMPOSED
- 11 [ENFORCEMENT]. [(a)] If the owner of a motor vehicle is delinquent
- 12 in the payment of a civil penalty imposed under this chapter,
- 13 <u>neither</u> the county assessor-collector <u>nor</u> [or] the Texas Department
- 14 of Motor Vehicles may refuse to register a motor vehicle alleged to
- 15 have been involved in the violation.
- 16 [(b) This section does not apply to the registration of a
- 17 motor vehicle under Section 501.0234.
- SECTION 2. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails
- 19 over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011,
- 20 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 21 codes.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
