- 21 (2) in a manner that creates a substantial likelihood
- that the illegal alien will suffer bodily injury. 22
- (e) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this 23

- 1 third degree of consanguinity or at the time of the offense within
- 2 <u>the third degree of affinity.</u>
- 3 (f) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 4 also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
- 5 <u>actor may be prosecuted under either section.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
