## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to auxiliary members of an appraisal review board.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 6, Tax Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 6.414 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 6.414. AUXILIARY APPRAISAL REVIEW BOARD MEMBERS IN
- 7 CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section applies only to an appraisal
- 8 district established in a county with a population of 3.3 million or
- 9 more.

- 10 (b) The board of directors of an appraisal district by
- 11 resolution of a majority of the members may provide for a number of
- 12 <u>auxiliary appraisal review board members that the board considers</u>
- 13 appropriate to hear taxpayer protests before the appraisal review
- 14 board and to assist the board in performing its duties.
- 15 (c) An auxiliary board member is appointed in the same
- 16 manner and for the same term as an appraisal review board member
- 17 under Section 6.41 and is subject to the same eligibility
- 18 requirements and restrictions as a board member under Sections
- 19 <u>6.41</u>, <u>6.411</u>, <u>6.412</u>, and <u>6.413</u>.
- 20 <u>(d) An auxiliary board member may attend meetings of the</u>
- 21 appraisal review board but may not vote in a determination made by
- 22 the board or serve as chairman or secretary of the board. An
- 23 <u>auxiliary board member is not included in determining what</u>
- 24 constitutes a quorum of the board or whether a quorum is present at

- 1 any meeting of the board.
- 2 (e) An auxiliary board member may hear taxpayer protests
- 3 before the appraisal review board. If one or more auxiliary board
- 4 members sit on a panel established under Section 41.45 to conduct a
- 5 protest hearing, the number of regular appraisal review board
- 6 members required by that section to constitute the panel is reduced
- 7 by the number of auxiliary board members sitting. An auxiliary
- 8 board member sitting on a panel is considered a regular board member
- 9 for all purposes related to the conduct of the hearing.
- 10 (f) An auxiliary board member is entitled to make a
- 11 recommendation to the appraisal review board regarding a protest
- 12 heard by the member but is not entitled to vote on the determination
- of the protest by the board.
- 14 (g) An auxiliary board member is entitled to compensation as
- 15 provided by the appraisal district budget and is not entitled to a
- 16 per diem or reimbursement of expenses under Section 6.42(c).
- 17 (h) Except as provided by this section, in this title,
- 18 "appraisal review board member" includes an auxiliary appraisal
- 19 review board member.
- SECTION 2. Section 6.412(f), Tax Code, is amended to read
- 21 as follows:
- 22 (f) In this section, a reference to an auxiliary board
- 23 member includes [means] an appraisal review board auxiliary member
- 24 appointed under Section 6.411, as that law existed before January
- 25 1, 2002.
- SECTION 3. Section 6.414, Tax Code, as added by this Act,
- 27 applies only to the appointment of an auxiliary member of an

- 1 appraisal review board for a term beginning on or after January 1,
- 2 2012.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
