## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to permit application requirements for solid waste
3	facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 361.064, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) A permit application under this subchapter must
8	<u>contain:</u>
9	(1) a certification from the applicant that the
10	applicant has mailed to each resident living one mile or less from
11	the site and each community organization, nonprofit organization,
12	or civic club located two miles or less from the site:
13	(A) an explanation of the site's proposed
14	operations; and
15	(B) a questionnaire seeking community comments
16	regarding the site's proposed operations; and
17	(2) any comments made by residents, organizations, or
18	clubs in response to the questionnaire.
19	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
20	to an application for a permit that is submitted to the Texas
21	Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
22	of this Act. An application for a permit that was submitted to the
23	Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date
24	of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the

- 1 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for 2 that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
