A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the punishment for the offense of indecent exposure.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.08, Penal Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor,
- 8 except that the offense is a state jail felony if it is shown on the
- 9 trial of the offense that the defendant has been previously
- 10 convicted two or more times of an offense under this section.
- (c) For purposes of Subsection (b), a defendant has been
- 12 previously convicted under this section if the defendant was
- 13 adjudged guilty of the offense or entered a plea of guilty or nolo
- 14 contendere in return for a grant of deferred adjudication,
- 15 regardless of whether the sentence for the offense was ever imposed
- 16 or whether the sentence was probated and the defendant was
- 17 subsequently discharged from community supervision.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 23 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 24 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
