## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the establishment of an interagency council for addressing disproportionality. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Title 1, Human Resources Code, is amended by 5 adding Chapter 2 to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 2. INTERAGENCY COUNCIL FOR ADDRESSING DISPROPORTIONALITY 7 Sec. 2.001. INTERAGENCY COUNCIL FOR ADDRESSING 8 DISPROPORTIONALITY. The Interagency Council for Addressing 9 Disproportionality is established to: 10 11 (1) examine the level of disproportionate involvement 12 of children who are members of a racial or ethnic minority group at each stage in the juvenile justice, child welfare, education, and 13 14 mental health systems, including: (A) the points of entry; 15 16 (B) each point at which a treatment decision is 17 made; and 18 (C) the outcomes for the children exiting the 19 systems; and 20 (2) make recommendations to reduce the involvement of 21 the children in the systems. Sec. 2.002. COMPOSITION OF COUNCIL; MEETINGS. (a) The 22 23 council consists of: 24 (1) one representative from each of the following

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
