## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to removal of the requirement that an electric utility
- 3 designate a preferred route for a transmission line in an
- 4 application for a certificate of convenience and necessity.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.053, Utilities Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c) The commission may not require the applicant to</u>
- 9 <u>designate a preferred route for a proposed transmission line</u>
- 10 <u>facility</u>.
- 11 SECTION 2. The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 12 adopt or revise rules under Section 37.053, Utilities Code, as
- 13 amended by this Act, before June 1, 2012.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an application for a
- 15 certificate of convenience and necessity that is filed with the
- 16 Public Utility Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act. An application for a certificate of convenience and
- 18 necessity that was filed with the commission before the effective
- 19 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 20 application was filed, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
