- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29.255, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
- 8 the agency shall allocate state and federal adult basic education
- 9 funds, other than federal funds set aside for state administration,
- 10 special projects, and staff development, on the following basis:
- 11 (1) 75 percent of the funds available shall be
- 12 <u>allocated based on the best available estimates of the number of</u>
- 13 eligible adults in each county and school district geographic area
- 14 within each county; and
- 15 (2) 25 percent of the funds available shall be
- 16 allocated based on student contact hours reported by each school
- 17 district geographic area for the most recent complete fiscal year
- 18 <u>reporting period</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
