A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to a notification requirement if a counselor is not 3 assigned to a public school campus.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 33.008 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.008. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING SCHOOL
- 8 COUNSELORS. (a) A public school, including an open-enrollment
- 9 charter school, that does not have a full-time school counselor
- 10 <u>certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, assigned to the campus</u>
- 11 for more than 30 consecutive instructional days during the same
- 12 school year shall provide written notice of the absence of a
- 13 counselor to the parent of or other person standing in parental
- 14 relation to each student enrolled in the school.
- 15 (b) The principal of the school shall provide the notice
- 16 required by Subsection (a) not later than the 30th instructional
- 17 day after the first day the school does not have a full-time school
- 18 counselor assigned to the campus.
- 19 (c) The school shall:
- 20 (1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice
- 21 required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any
- 22 parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary
- 23 language is not English; and
- 24 (2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this

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1 section.

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
