4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 437 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 437. BENEFITS FOR SURVIVORS OF TEXAS NATIONAL GUARD
8	<u>MEMBERS</u>
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 437.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "eligible
11	survivor" means a person eligible to receive benefits under this
12	chapter.
13	Sec. 437.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies only to
14	eligible survivors of a Texas National Guard member who died after
15	September 11, 2001, while:
16	(1) on federal active duty under Title 10, United
17	States Code; or
18	(2) serving in a named military operation on active
19	duty under state authority in accordance with Title 32, United
20	States Code.
21	Sec. 437.003. ADDITIONAL BENEFIT. The benefit provided
22	under this chapter is in addition to any other benefit provided
23	under state or federal law.

## 1 SUBCHAPTER B. ADMINISTRATION OF CHAPTER 2 Sec. 437.051. ADJUTANT GENERAL. The adjutant general shall administer this chapter for the payment of benefits to eliqible 3 survivors of Texas National Guard members. 4 Sec. 437.052. RULES. The adjutant general shall adopt 5 rules to administer this chapter, including rules and procedures 6 7 for making and proving a claim, appealing decisions, and receiving 8 benefits under this chapter. 9 Sec. 437.053. GIFTS; GRANTS. The adjutant general may 10 accept gifts and grants to make payments under this chapter. Sec. 437.054. CERTIFICATION TO COMPTROLLER. The adjutant 11 12 general shall certify to the comptroller:

14 a benefit under this chapter; and

(1) the name of each eligible survivor who will be paid

- (2) the amount of the benefit to be paid to each 15

- Sec. 437.101. ELIGIBILITY. (a) In this section, "heirs" 20
- has the meaning assigned by Section 3, Texas Probate Code. 21
- (b) An eligible survivor is a person designated as a 22
- beneficiary on the deceased Texas National Guard member's group 23
- 24 life insurance program under 38 U.S.C. Section 1965 et seq.
- 25 (c) If there is not a beneficiary for the Texas National
- 26 Guard member under Subsection (b), the eligible survivors are the
- 27 heirs.

- 1 Sec. 437.102. PAYMENT TO ELIGIBLE SURVIVOR. (a) The state
- 2 shall pay \$250,000 to the eligible survivor of a Texas National
- 3 Guard member or the appropriate pro rata portion of that amount to
- 4 the eligible survivors of the member. The state shall pay the
- 5 benefits in two equal installments.
- 6 (b) The state is required to make payments under this
- 7 <u>section only to the extent that the legislature specifically</u>
- 8 appropriates money for that purpose.
- 9 Sec. 437.103. APPLICATION FOR BENEFITS. An eligible
- 10 survivor must apply for benefits in accordance with rules adopted
- 11 under this chapter.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
