4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 601, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 601.0535 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 601.0535. IMPOUNDMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE BY PEACE
8	OFFICER. (a) A peace officer may impound the vehicle of a person
9	who:
10	(1) operates a motor vehicle in violation of Section
11	601.051; and
12	(2) fails to display a driver's license to the officer
13	under Section 521.025.
14	(b) A peace officer who impounds a motor vehicle under
15	Subsection (a) shall issue the person a written explanation, on a
16	form designed by the law enforcement agency that employs the
17	officer, as to how the owner or operator of the vehicle may recover
18	the motor vehicle from that law enforcement agency.
19	(c) The law enforcement agency that impounds a motor vehicle
20	under Subsection (a) may release the vehicle to the owner or

(1) provides to the law enforcement agency evidence

- 1 vehicle was impounded, the motor vehicle was in compliance with
- 2 Section 601.051;
- 3 (B) Section 601.052, showing that on that date
- 4 the vehicle was exempt from the requirements of Section 601.051; or
- 5 (C) Section 601.053, showing that financial
- 6 responsibility for the vehicle has been obtained and is valid;
- 7 (2) provides to the law enforcement agency a driver's
- 8 license issued to that person; and
- 9 (3) pays for the cost of the impoundment.
- 10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2011. An offense
- 12 committed before September 1, 2011, is governed by the law in effect
- 13 on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 14 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 15 an offense was committed before September 1, 2011, if any element of
- 16 the offense occurred before that date.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
