A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to initial claims under the unemployment compensation 3 system.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 208.002, Labor Code, is amended to read 6 as follows:

Sec. 208.002. [NOTICE OF] INITIAL CLAIM; LAST WORK. (a)
When used in connection with an initial claim, "last work" and
"person for whom the claimant last worked" refer to:

10 <u>(1) the last person for whom the claimant actually</u> 11 worked, if the claimant worked for that person for at least 30 hours 12 <u>during a week; or</u>

13 (2) the employer, as defined by Subchapter C, Chapter 14 201, or by the unemployment law of any other state, for whom the 15 claimant last worked.

16 (b) The commission shall mail a notice of the filing of an 17 initial claim to the person for whom the claimant last worked before 18 the effective date of the initial claim. If the person for whom the 19 claimant last worked has more than one branch or division operating 20 at different locations, the commission shall mail the notice to the 21 branch or division at which the claimant last worked.

22 (c) [(b)] Mailing of a notice under this section to the 23 correct address of the person, branch, or division for which the 24 claimant last worked constitutes notice of the claim to the person.

1 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 2 a claim for unemployment compensation benefits that is filed with 3 the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of 4 this Act. A claim filed before that date is governed by the law in 5 effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is 6 continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
