A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the collection and use of fingerprints of an applicant
- 3 for a driver's license, personal identification certificate, or
- 4 commercial driver's license.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 411.088(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Section 521.0491(e),
- 9 Transportation Code, the [The] department may charge a person that
- 10 is not primarily a criminal justice agency a fee for processing
- 11 inquiries for criminal history record information. The department
- 12 may charge:

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- 13 (1) a fee of \$10 for each inquiry for criminal history
- 14 record information on a person that is processed only on the basis
- 15 of the person's name, unless the inquiry is submitted
- 16 electronically or by magnetic media, in which event the fee is \$1;
- 17 (2) a fee of \$15 for each inquiry for criminal history
- 18 record information on a person that is processed on the basis of a
- 19 fingerprint comparison search; and
- 20 (3) except as provided by Subsection (b), actual costs
- 21 for processing all other information inquiries.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
- 23 is amended by adding Section 521.0491 to read as follows:
- Sec. 521.0491. FINGERPRINT INFORMATION SUPPLIED TO CERTAIN

- 1 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES. (a) In this section:
- 2 (1) "State agency" means a department, commission,
- 3 board, office, council, authority, or other agency in the
- 4 executive, legislative, or judicial branch of state government that
- 5 is created by the constitution or a statute of this state, including
- 6 <u>a university system or institution of higher education, as defined</u>
- 7 by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 8 (2) "Written consent" includes consent given by an
- 9 electronic signature.
- 10 (b) The department shall retain fingerprints provided to
- 11 the department by an applicant under Section 521.142(b) or by an
- 12 applicant for a personal identification certificate or commercial
- 13 driver's license.
- 14 (c) With the written consent of the applicant who provided
- 15 the fingerprints and on request, the department shall:
- 16 (1) provide or make available the applicant's
- 17 fingerprints to a state agency for use by the agency in carrying out
- 18 its functions; and
- 19 (2) use the applicant's fingerprints in another
- 20 application under this subtitle submitted by the applicant.
- 21 (d) A state agency may use fingerprints provided or made
- 22 available to the agency under this section to obtain criminal
- 23 history record information to which the agency is entitled under
- 24 Subchapter F, Chapter 411, Government Code.
- (e) Notwithstanding any other law, the department may not
- 26 charge a fee for:
- 27 (1) providing, using, or making available the

- 1 applicant's fingerprints under Subsection (c); or
- 2 (2) processing an inquiry from a state agency for
- 3 criminal history record information on the basis of fingerprints
- 4 provided or made available under Subsection (c).
- 5 (f) Section 503.001, Business & Commerce Code, does not
- 6 apply to the maintenance or provision of fingerprints under this
- 7 section.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 521.052, Transportation Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 521.052. DISCLOSURE OF INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION
- 11 PROHIBITED. Except as provided by Sections 521.045, 521.046,
- 12 521.0475, 521.0491, 521.049(c), and 521.050, and by Chapter 730,
- 13 the department may not disclose information from the department's
- 14 files that relates to personal information, as that term is defined
- 15 by Section 730.003.
- SECTION 4. Section 521.142(b), Transportation Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (b) The application must include:
- 19 (1) the complete set of fingerprints [the thumbprints]
- 20 of the applicant [or, if thumbprints cannot be taken, the index
- 21 fingerprints of the applicant];
- 22 (2) a photograph of the applicant;
- 23 (3) the signature of the applicant; and
- 24 (4) a brief description of the applicant.
- 25 SECTION 5. Section 730.010, Transportation Code, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- Sec. 730.010. DISCLOSURE OF THUMB OR FINGER IMAGES

- 1 PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
- 2 if an agency obtains an image of an individual's thumb or finger in
- 3 connection with the issuance of a license, permit, or certificate
- 4 to the individual, the agency may:
- 5 (1) use the image only:
- 6 (A) in connection with the issuance of the
- 7 license, permit, or certificate; [ex]
- 8 (B) to verify the identity of an individual as
- 9 provided by Section 521.059;
- 10 (C) as authorized under Section 521.0491; or
- 11 (D) for criminal justice purposes; and
- 12 (2) disclose the image only if disclosure is expressly
- 13 authorized by law.
- SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 15 an application for a driver's license, personal identification
- 16 certificate, or commercial driver's license that is submitted on or
- 17 after January 1, 2012. An application submitted before January 1,
- 18 2012, is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 19 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
