3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 21.054, Education Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsections (b), (c), and (d) to read as follows:
6	(b) Continuing education requirements for an educator must
7	provide that 25 percent of the training required every five years
8	include instruction regarding:
9	(1) collecting and analyzing information that will
10	improve effectiveness in the classroom;
11	(2) integrating technology into classroom
12	instruction;
13	(3) educating diverse student populations, including:
14	(A) students with disabilities;
15	(B) students who are economically disadvantaged;
16	and
17	(C) students of limited English proficiency; and
18	(4) the subject area taught by the educator.
19	(c) Continuing education requirements each year for an
20	educator primarily employed at a school campus that for more than
21	two consecutive years has failed to meet a Performance-Based
22	Monitoring Analysis System indicator standard established by the
23	commissioner or a standard established by the commissioner under
24	Section 39.053(e) or (f) must include training specifically

1 <u>developed to assist the educator in improving campus performance on</u>
2 <u>the indicators and standards.</u>

3 (d) Continuing education requirements for an educator each 4 year must be linked to any areas identified in the educator's 5 appraisal as needing improvement.

6 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2012, the State Board 7 for Educator Certification shall propose rules implementing 8 Section 21.054, Education Code, as amended by this Act.

9 SECTION 3. An educator subject to continuing education 10 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is 11 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements 12 described by Section 21.054(b), Education Code, as added by this 13 Act, for any continuing education requirements period that ends 14 before January 1, 2015.

15 SECTION 4. An educator subject to continuing education 16 requirements immediately before the effective date of this Act is 17 not required to comply with the continuing education requirements 18 described by Section 21.054(c) or (d), Education Code, as added by 19 this Act, for any continuing education requirements period that 20 ends before January 1, 2014.

21 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2012-2013 22 school year.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
