A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the de-annexation of land in Bastrop County by the
- 3 Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Not later than the 30th day after the effective
- 6 date of this Act, the board of the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer
- 7 Conservation District shall declare by resolution that the
- 8 territory described by Section 2 of this Act is excluded from the
- 9 territory of the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation
- 10 District. The board shall file a copy of the resolution in the
- 11 office of the county clerk of the county in which the excluded
- 12 territory is located. The county clerk shall record the resolution
- 13 in the county records. On the date the resolution is recorded, the
- 14 excluded territory is no longer part of that district.
- 15 SECTION 2. The territory to be de-annexed by the Barton
- 16 Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District under this Act is the
- 17 territory contained in the following area:
- 18 BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of Travis County, Bastrop
- 19 County, and Caldwell County;
- 20 THENCE, 1840 feet, more or less, N 48° E, along the Bastrop/Travis
- 21 County Line to an angle point;
- 22 THENCE, 9720 feet, more or less, S 47° E, passing State Highway 21 to
- 23 an angle point;
- 24 THENCE, 1670 feet, more or less, S 70° W, to an angle point in the

- 1 Bastrop/Caldwell County Line;
- 2 THENCE, 8840 feet, more or less, N 43° W, along the Bastrop/Caldwell
- 3 County Line and passing State Highway 21 to the Point of Beginning.
- 4 All of the area enclosed by this description is in Bastrop County
- 5 and totals approximately 410 acres.
- 6 Reference: Original mapping of Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply
- 7 Corporation boundaries as shown on the CCN Map of Record, Oct 18,
- 8 2006, held by TCEQ for Water CCN Number 11029.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
