1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the de-annexation of land in Bastrop County by the
1-9 Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Not later than the 30th day after the effective
1-12 date of this Act, the board of the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer
1-13 Conservation District shall declare by resolution that the
1-14 territory described by Section 2 of this Act is excluded from the
1-15 territory of the Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation
1-16 District. The board shall file a copy of the resolution in the
1-17 office of the county clerk of the county in which the excluded
1-18 territory is located. The county clerk shall record the resolution
1-19 in the county records. On the date the resolution is recorded, the
1-20 excluded territory is no longer part of that district.

1-21 SECTION 2. The territory to be de-annexed by the Barton
1-22 Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District under this Act is the
1-23 territory contained in the following area:

1-24 BEGINNING AT A POINT at the intersection of Travis County, Bastrop
1-25 County, and Caldwell County;

1-26 THENCE, 1840 feet, more or less, N 48° E, along the Bastrop/Travis
1-27 County Line to an angle point;

1-28 THENCE, 9720 feet, more or less, S 47° E, passing State Highway 21 to
1-29 an angle point;

1-30 THENCE, 1670 feet, more or less, S 70° W, to an angle point in the
1-31 Bastrop/Caldwell County Line;

1-32 THENCE, 8840 feet, more or less, N 43° W, along the Bastrop/Caldwell
1-33 County Line and passing State Highway 21 to the Point of Beginning.

1-34 All of the area enclosed by this description is in Bastrop County
1-35 and totals approximately 410 acres.

1-36 Reference: Original mapping of Creedmoor-Maha Water Supply
1-37 Corporation boundaries as shown on the CCN Map of Record, Oct 18,
1-38 2006, held by TCEQ for Water CCN Number 11029.

1-39 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
