## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the State Bar of Texas membership dues for an attorney
3 employed by the office of the attorney general.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 81.054, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:
- (m) A member is not required to pay a membership fee for a

  8 year in which the member is in good standing and employed as a

  9 full-time attorney by the office of the attorney general. The state

  10 bar shall adopt rules governing the proration of a membership fee

  11 paid by an attorney who is employed by the office of the attorney

  12 general for part, but not all, of a year. This subsection expires
- 13 <u>January 1, 2016.</u>

- SECTION 2. Section 81.054(m), Government Code, as added by 14 this Act, applies to a membership fee for membership or renewal of 15 membership in the State Bar of Texas that becomes due on or after 16 the effective date of this Act. A membership fee for membership or 17 renewal of membership that becomes due before the effective date of 18 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the membership 19 fee becomes due, and the former law is continued in effect for that 20 purpose. 21
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2012.
