- 2 relating to the State Bar of Texas membership dues for an attorney
- 3 employed by this state's government.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 81.054, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:
- 7 (m) A member is not required to pay a membership fee for a
- 8 year in which the member is in good standing and employed as a
- 9 full-time attorney by a board, commission, department, agency,
- 10 office, or other entity of this state's government. The state bar
- 11 shall adopt rules governing the proration of a membership fee paid
- 12 by an attorney who is not employed by this state's government for an
- 13 entire year.
- SECTION 2. Section 81.054(m), Government Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies to a membership fee for membership or renewal of
- 16 membership in the State Bar of Texas that becomes due on or after
- 17 the effective date of this Act. A membership fee for membership or
- 18 renewal of membership that becomes due before the effective date of
- 19 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the membership
- 20 fee becomes due, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2012.
