2 relating to the hours during which the polls are open for early

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.004(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) The [If early voting by personal appearance is required
- 8 to be conducted for extended hours under Section 85.005(c) or for
- 9 weekend hours under Section 85.006(e), the] registrar's office
- 10 shall remain open for providing voter registration information
- 11 during the [extended hours or weekend] hours that the main early
- 12 voting polling place is open for voting.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 85.005, Election Code, is amended by
- 14 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), (c-1), or (d), in
- 17 an election in which a county clerk or city secretary is the early
- 18 voting clerk under Section 83.002 or 83.005, early voting by
- 19 personal appearance at the main early voting polling place shall be
- 20 conducted on the weekdays of the early voting period and during the
- 21 hours that the county clerk's or city secretary's main business
- 22 office is regularly open for business.
- (c) In a county with a population of 100,000 or more but less
- 24 than 500,000, the voting in a primary election or the general

- 1 election for state and county officers shall be conducted at the
- 2 main early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each
- 3 weekday of the last week of the early voting period, and the voting
- 4 in a special election ordered by the governor shall be conducted at
- 5 the main early voting polling place for at least 12 hours on each of
- 6 the last two days of the early voting period. Voting shall be
- 7 conducted in accordance with this subsection in those elections in
- 8 a county with a population under 100,000 on receipt by the early
- 9 voting clerk of a written request for the extended hours submitted
- 10 by at least 15 registered voters of the county. The request must be
- 11 submitted in time to enable compliance with Section 85.067.
- 12 <u>(c-1)</u> In a county with a population of 500,000 or more, the
- 13 voting in a primary election or the general election for state and
- 14 county officers or a special election ordered by the governor shall
- 15 be conducted at the main early voting polling place until at least 7
- 16 p.m. on each weekday of the first week of the early voting period
- 17 and from 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. on each weekday of the remainder of the
- 18 early voting period.
- 19 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 an election for which early voting begins on or after September 1,
- 21 2011.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
