- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 254.036(b), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), (e), or (f), each
- 8 report filed under this chapter with the commission must be filed:
- 9 (1) by computer diskette, modem, or other means of
- 10 electronic transfer, using computer software provided by the
- 11 commission or computer software that meets commission
- 12 specifications for a standard file format; or
- 13 (2) using a secure Internet website maintained by the
- 14 commission that meets the requirements of Section 571.0671,
- 15 Government Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 302.013(d), Government Code, is amended
- 17 to read as follows:
- 18 (d) Each speaker candidate shall file the statement:
- 19 <u>(1)</u> by computer diskette, modem, or other means of
- 20 electronic transfer, using computer software provided by the Texas
- 21 Ethics Commission or computer software that meets commission
- 22 specifications for a standard file format; or
- 23 (2) using a secure Internet website maintained by the
- 24 Texas Ethics Commission that meets the requirements of Section

- 1 571.0671.
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 305.0064(a), Government Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), each registration
- 5 filed under Section 305.005 and each report filed under Section
- 6 305.006 must be filed:
- 7 (1) by computer diskette, modem, or other means of
- 8 electronic transfer, using computer software provided by the
- 9 commission or computer software that meets commission
- 10 specifications for a standard file format; or
- 11 (2) using a secure Internet website maintained by the
- 12 commission that meets the requirements of Section 571.0671.
- 13 SECTION 4. The heading to Section 571.0671, Government
- 14 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 571.0671. REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTRONIC FILING SOFTWARE
- 16 OR INTERNET WEBSITE.
- SECTION 5. Section 571.0671, Government Code, is amended by
- 18 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 19 as follows:
- 20 (a) Computer software provided or approved by the
- 21 commission or the secure Internet website for use under Section
- 22 254.036(b), Election Code, or Section 302.013 or 305.0064 must:
- (1) use a standardized format for the entry of names,
- 24 addresses, and zip codes;
- 25 (2) provide for secure and encoded transmission of
- 26 data from the computer of a person filing a report to the computers
- 27 used by the commission;

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- 1 (3) be capable of being used by a person with basic
- 2 computing skills;
- 3 (4) provide confirmation to a person filing a report
- 4 that the report was properly received; and
- 5 (5) permit a person using a computer to prepare a
- 6 report or to retrieve information from a report to import
- 7 information to the report from a variety of computer software
- 8 applications that meet commission specifications for a standard
- 9 file format or export information from the report to a variety of
- 10 computer software applications that meet commission specifications
- 11 for a standard file format without the need to reenter information.
- 12 (c) The commission may provide software for use under
- 13 Section 254.036(b), Election Code, or Section 302.013 or 305.0064
- 14 by making the software available on the Internet. If the commission
- 15 makes the software available on the Internet, the commission is not
- 16 required to provide the software on computer diskettes, CD-ROMs, or
- 17 other storage media without charge to persons required to file
- 18 reports under that section, but may charge a fee for providing the
- 19 software on storage media. A fee under this subsection may not
- 20 exceed the cost to the commission of providing the software.
- 21 Provision of software on the Internet under this subsection does
- 22 not affect the duty of the commission to maintain a secure Internet
- 23 website through which a person may electronically file reports
- 24 without acquiring the software described by this section.
- 25 (d) The commission shall maintain a secure Internet website
- 26 through which a person may directly electronically file reports
- 27 with the commission under Section 254.036(b), Election Code, or

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- 1 Section 302.013 or 305.0064 without acquiring the software
- 2 described by this section. The website shall, in addition to
- 3 meeting the requirements of Subsection (a), provide adequate
- 4 controls to ensure that only the person required to file the report,
- 5 or another person authorized by the person required to file the
- 6 report, may enter or alter information or submit the report to the
- 7 <u>commission</u>.
- 8 SECTION 6. Subchapter C, Chapter 571, Government Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Sections 571.080 and 571.081 to read as follows:
- Sec. 571.080. ASSISTANCE FOR FILER. The commission must
- 11 provide a service that enables a person required to file a report
- 12 with the commission to speak to or communicate electronically in
- 13 real time with commission staff to assist the person in preparing
- 14 and filing the report. This service must be continuously available
- 15 beginning 24 hours before the time and date of a deadline for filing
- 16 <u>a report with the commission and ending on the deadline for filing</u>
- 17 the report.
- 18 Sec. 571.081. AVAILABILITY OF DIRECT TELEPHONE NUMBER OF
- 19 COMMISSION STAFF TO FILER. An employee of the commission shall on
- 20 request provide the employee's direct telephone number to a person
- 21 required to file a report with the commission.
- SECTION 7. Section 571.123(b), Government Code, is amended
- 23 to read as follows:
- (b) After a complaint is filed, the commission shall
- 25 immediately attempt to contact and notify the respondent of the
- 26 complaint by telephone or electronic mail. Not later than the
- 27 fifth business day after the date a complaint is filed, the

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- 1 commission shall send written notice to the complainant and the
- 2 respondent. The written notice to the complainant and the
- 3 respondent must:
- 4 (1) state whether the complaint complies with the form
- 5 requirements of Section 571.122;
- 6 (2) state the procedure by which the respondent may
- 7 designate an agent with whom commission staff may discuss the
- 8 complaint;
- 9 (3) state that the respondent may request the direct
- 10 telephone number of the commission staff member who will perform
- 11 the processing of the complaint against the respondent; and
- (4) $[\frac{(2)}{2}]$ if applicable, include the information
- 13 required by Section 571.124(e).
- SECTION 8. Subchapter E, Chapter 571, Government Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Sections 571.1231 and 571.1232 to read as
- 16 follows:
- 17 Sec. 571.1231. DESIGNATION OF AGENT BY RESPONDENT. (a) A
- 18 respondent to a complaint filed against the respondent may by
- 19 writing submitted to the commission designate an agent with whom
- 20 the commission staff may communicate regarding the complaint.
- 21 (b) For purposes of this subchapter, including Section
- 22 571.140, communications with the respondent's agent designated
- 23 under this section are considered communications with the
- 24 respondent.
- Sec. 571.1232. PROVISION OF TELEPHONE NUMBER TO RESPONDENT.
- 26 On request, the commission shall provide to a respondent the direct
- 27 telephone number of the commission staff member who will perform

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- 1 the processing of the complaint against the respondent.
- 2 SECTION 9. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 3 of this Act, the Texas Ethics Commission shall establish the secure
- 4 Internet website on which a report may be filed as provided by the
- 5 changes in law made by this Act.
- 6 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
