1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the issuance of an identification card to certain
1-9 honorably retired peace officers.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 614.124(a), Government Code, as added by
1-12 Chapter 938 (H.B. 3613), Acts of the 80th Legislature, Regular
1-13 Session, 2007, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 (a) On request of an honorably retired peace officer who
1-15 holds a certificate of proficiency under Section 1701.357,
1-16 Occupations Code, the [The] law enforcement agency or other
1-17 governmental entity that was the last entity to appoint or employ
1-18 the [an] honorably retired peace officer as a peace officer shall
1-19 [may] issue an identification card to the [its] honorably retired
1-20 peace officer [officers].

1-21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
