5	SECTION 1. Section 1001.407, Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1001.407. CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC WORKS. <u>(a)</u>
8	Except as provided by Subsection (b), this [The] state or a
9	political subdivision of <u>this</u> [the] state may not construct a
10	public work involving engineering in which the public health,
11	welfare, or safety is involved, unless:
12	(1) the engineering plans, specifications, and
13	estimates have been prepared by an engineer; and
14	(2) the engineering construction is to be performed
15	under the direct supervision of an engineer.
16	(b) This section does not apply to a building or other
17	facility that:
18	(1) is occupied exclusively by a volunteer fire
19	department, as defined by Section 152.001, Tax Code, in a county
20	with a population of 80,000 or less;
21	(2) is not routinely used by the public;
22	(3) is approved by an engineer, including an approval
23	evidenced by an engineer stamp on a plan or document for a
24	prefabricated building; and

1 (4) has a slab that is approved by an engineer for the 2 specific building approved under Subdivision (3), including an 3 approval evidenced by an engineer stamp on a plan or document of the 4 slab's intended purpose.

5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
