H.B. No. 1097

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to including in the annual report of a local school health
3 advisory council to a school district board of trustees information
4 related to funding of programs designed to promote improved student
5 health.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 28.004(m), Education Code, is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 (m) In addition to performing other duties, the local school
10 health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at
11 least annually, a written report that includes:

12 (1) any council recommendation concerning the school
13 district's health education curriculum and instruction or related
14 matters that the council has not previously submitted to the board;

15 (2) any suggested modification to a council
16 recommendation previously submitted to the board; ~~and~~

17 (3) a detailed explanation of the council's activities
18 during the period between the date of the current report and the
19 date of the last prior written report;

20 (4) a determination of the funding necessary to
21 implement and operate:

22 (A) a coordinated health program described by
23 Section 38.013; and

24 (B) any required state or federal health program

1 related to student nutrition and physical fitness; and

2 (5) an analysis of the expenditure of funds received
3 by the district for a program under Subdivision (4).

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
