- 3 SECTION 2. Section 5(a-1), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 4 Procedure, as added by this Act, applies to a defendant placed on
- 5 deferred adjudication community supervision on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the offense for
- 7 which the defendant is placed on deferred adjudication community
- 8 supervision is committed before, on, or after that date.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 5(c-1), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal
- 10 Procedure, as added by this Act, applies to an order of dismissal
- 11 and discharge entered on or after the effective date of this Act,
- 12 regardless of whether the defendant is placed on deferred
- 13 adjudication community supervision before, on, or after that date.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
