Section 24.0051(d), Property Code, is amended to 6 read as follows: 7 (d) In a suit described by Subsection (c), the citation 8 9 required by Rule 739, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, must include the following notice to the defendant on the first page of the 10 citation in English and Spanish and in conspicuous bold print: 11 12 SUIT TO EVICT 13 THIS SUIT TO EVICT INVOLVES IMMEDIATE DEADLINES. A TENANT WHO IS SERVING ON ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY MAY HAVE SPECIAL RIGHTS OR 14 RELIEF RELATED TO THIS SUIT UNDER FEDERAL LAW, INCLUDING THE 15 16 SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL RELIEF ACT (50 U.S.C. APP. SECTION 501 ET SEQ.), OR STATE LAW, INCLUDING SECTION 92.017, TEXAS PROPERTY CODE. 17 CALL THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS TOLL-FREE AT 1-877-9TEXBAR IF YOU NEED 18 HELP LOCATING AN ATTORNEY. IF YOU CANNOT AFFORD TO HIRE AN 19 ATTORNEY, YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR FREE OR LOW-COST LEGAL 20 21 ASSISTANCE.

22 SECTION 2. Section 51.002, Property Code, is amended by 23 adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:

24 (i) A notice served on a debtor under this section must

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1	contain, in addition to any other statements required under this
2	section, language substantially similar to the following:
3	"A debtor who is serving on active military duty may have
4	special rights or relief related to this notice under federal law,
5	including the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (50 U.S.C. app.
6	Section 501 et seq.), and state law, including Section 51.015,
7	Texas Property Code."
8	SECTION 3. Section 209.006(b), Property Code, is amended to
9	read as follows:
10	(b) The notice must:
11	(1) describe the violation or property damage that is
12	the basis for the suspension action, charge, or fine and state any
13	amount due the association from the owner; and
14	(2) inform the owner that the owner:
15	(A) is entitled to a reasonable period to cure
16	the violation and avoid the fine or suspension unless the owner was
17	given notice and a reasonable opportunity to cure a similar
18	violation within the preceding six months; [and]
19	(B) may request a hearing under Section 209.007
20	on or before the 30th day after the date the owner receives the
21	notice; and
22	(C) may have special rights or relief related to
23	the enforcement action under federal law, including the
24	Servicemembers Civil Relief Act (50 U.S.C. app. Section 501 et
25	seq.), if the owner is serving on active military duty.
26	SECTION 4. The change in law made by Section 24.0051,
27	Property Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a suit for

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1 which notice is required under Chapter 24, Property Code, that is 2 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A suit for which 3 notice is required under Chapter 24, Property Code, that is filed 4 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 5 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that 6 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 5. The change in law made by Section 51.002, 8 Property Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a sale for which a notice is required under that section on or after the 9 effective date of this Act. A sale for which notice is required 10 under Section 51.002, Property Code, before the effective date of 11 this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before the 12 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 13 14 that purpose.

SECTION 6. The change in law made by Section 209.006, 15 Property Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an 16 17 enforcement action for which a notice is required under that section that commences on or after the effective date of this Act. 18 An enforcement action for which notice is required under Section 19 209.006, Property Code, that commences before the effective date of 20 this Act is governed by the law in effect when the enforcement 21 action commenced, and that law is continued in effect for that 22 23 purpose.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect January 1, 2012.

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
