BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 521.426(a), Transportation Code, is 1-14 amended to read as follows:

1**-**15 1**-**16 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a veteran of service in the armed forces of the United States is exempt from the 1-17 payment of fees under this chapter for the issuance of a driver's license or personal identification certificate if the veteran: 1-18 1-19

(1)was honorably discharged;

1-20 1-21 (2) has a service-related disability of at least 60 percent; and

1-22 (3) receives compensation from the United States because of the disability. 1-23

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
