- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1001.501, Occupations Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1001.501. IMPOSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. (a)
- 9 Except as provided by Subsection (b), the [The] board may impose an
- 10 administrative penalty on a person who violates this chapter or a
- 11 rule adopted or order issued under this chapter.
- 12 (b) The board may not impose an administrative penalty for a
- 13 <u>violation of this chapter on:</u>
- 14 (1) a political subdivision of the state; or
- 15 (2) a public official or employee of the state or of a
- 16 political subdivision of the state who is not licensed under this
- 17 chapter.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter L, Chapter 1001, Occupations Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 1001.5531 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 1001.5531. ENFORCEMENT ACTION PROHIBITED AGAINST</u>
- 21 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS AND CERTAIN PUBLIC OFFICIALS.
- 22 Notwithstanding any other provision, the board may not take any
- 23 enforcement action for a violation of this chapter against:
- 24 (1) a political subdivision of the state; or

- 1 (2) a public official or employee of the state or of a
- 2 political subdivision of the state who is not licensed under this
- 3 <u>chapter.</u>
- 4 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 5 only to an administrative penalty assessed on or after the
- 6 effective date of this Act. An administrative penalty assessed
- 7 before the effective date of this Act is subject to the law in
- 8 effect immediately before that date, and that law is continued in
- 9 effect for that purpose.
- 10 (b) Section 1001.5531, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 11 Act, applies only to a violation for which an enforcement action is
- 12 commenced on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of
- 13 when the violation occurred. An action commenced before the
- 14 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 15 immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect
- 16 for that purpose.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
