- 8 (1) a determination is made under Subsection (b) that
- 9 drought conditions no longer exist; or
- 10 (2) a determination is made by the commissioners
- 11 court, or the county judge or fire marshal if designated for that
- 12 purpose by the commissioners court, that the circumstances
- 13 identified under Subsection (c)(2) no longer exist.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
