- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 26, Local Government Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 26.048 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 26.048. CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES WITH POPULATION OF
- 8 500,000 OR MORE: ELECTION FROM SINGLE-MEMBER DISTRICTS. (a) The
- 9 governing body of a municipality with a population of 500,000 or
- 10 more must consist of a mayor elected at large and at least six
- 11 members elected from single-member districts. A member must reside
- 12 <u>in the district the member represents.</u>
- 13 (b) The municipality may provide for the staggering of the
- 14 terms of the members of the municipality's governing body.
- 15 (c) A single-member district must be compact and consist of
- 16 contiguous territory. To the extent practicable, all single-member
- 17 districts must be of equal population.
- 18 (d) This section does not prevent a municipality from having
- 19 <u>additional members elected to the governing body from the</u>
- 20 municipality at large.
- 21 (e) A municipality must comply with this section beginning
- 22 with the first general election of members to the municipality's
- 23 governing body that occurs after the year in which the federal
- 24 decennial census indicates that the municipality meets the

- 1 population requirements of Subsection (a).
- 2 SECTION 2. A municipality to which Section 26.048, Local
- 3 Government Code, as added by this Act, applies on the effective date
- 4 of this Act must comply with the requirements of that section
- 5 beginning with the first general election of members to the
- 6 municipality's governing body that occurs after December 31, 2011.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
