The coordinating body shall designate additional representatives if 13 necessary to ensure adequate representation from the interests 14 comprising that region, including the public, 15 16 municipalities, industries, agricultural interests, environmental interests, small businesses, electric generating utilities, river 17 authorities, water districts, and water utilities. The regional 18 water planning group shall maintain adequate representation from 19

- 3 of this Act, the commissioners court of each county in this state
- 4 shall appoint an initial representative of the county to the
- 5 regional water planning group for the regional water planning area
- 6 in which the county is located, as required by Section 16.053(c),
- 7 Water Code, as amended by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
