A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 1 | AN ACT |
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| 2 | relating to the requirement and study of insurance coverage for |
| 3 | serious emotional disturbance of a child. |
| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Section 1355.001, Insurance Code, is amended by |
| 6 | adding Subdivision (5) to read as follows: |
| 7 | (5) "Serious emotional disturbance of a child" means |
| 8 | an emotional or behavioral disorder or a neuropsychiatric condition |
| 9 | that causes a person's functioning to be impaired in thought, |
| 10 | perception, affect, or behavior and that: |
| 11 | (A) has been diagnosed, by a physician licensed |
| 12 | to practice medicine in this state, a psychologist licensed to |
| 13 | practice in this state, or a licensed professional counselor |
| 14 | licensed to practice in this state, in a person who is at least |
| 15 | three years of age and younger than 17 years of age; and |
| 16 | (B) meets at least one of the following criteria: |
| 17 | (i) the disorder substantially impairs the |
| 18 | person's ability in at least two of the following activities or |
| 19 | tasks: |
| 20 | (a) self-care; |
| 21 | (b) engaging in family relationships; |
| 22 | (c) functioning in school; or |
| 23 | (d) functioning in the community; |
| 24 | (ii) the disorder creates a risk that the |

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- 1 person will be removed from the person's home and placed in a more
- 2 restrictive environment, including in a facility or program
- 3 operated by the Department of Family and Protective Services or an
- 4 agency that is part of the juvenile justice system;
- 5 (iii) the disorder causes the person to:
- 6 (a) display psychotic features or
- 7 <u>violent behavior; or</u>
- 8 (b) pose a danger to the person's self
- 9 or others; or
- 10 (iv) the disorder results in the person
- 11 meeting state special education eligibility requirements for
- 12 serious emotional disturbance.
- 13 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 1355.004, Insurance Code,
- 14 is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 1355.004. REQUIRED COVERAGE FOR SERIOUS EMOTIONAL
- 16 DISTURBANCE OF A CHILD AND SERIOUS MENTAL ILLNESS.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 1355.004, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 18 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) A group health benefit plan:
- 21 (1) must provide coverage <u>for serious emotional</u>
- 22 disturbance of a child diagnosed as described by Section
- 23 1355.001(5) and coverage, based on medical necessity, for serious
- 24 mental illness for not less than the following treatments [of
- 25 serious mental illness] in each calendar year:
- 26 (A) 45 days of inpatient treatment; and
- 27 (B) 60 visits for outpatient treatment,

- 1 including group and individual outpatient treatment;
- 2 (2) may not include a lifetime limitation on the
- 3 number of days of inpatient treatment or the number of visits for
- 4 outpatient treatment covered under the plan; and
- 5 (3) must include the same amount limitations,
- 6 deductibles, copayments, and coinsurance factors for <u>serious</u>
- 7 <u>emotional disturbance of a child and</u> serious mental illness as the
- 8 plan includes for physical illness.
- 9 (c) The department shall conduct a study to determine and
- 10 evaluate the extent to which enrollees are making claims under
- 11 coverage for serious emotional disturbance of a child and the
- 12 impact, if any, the coverage for serious emotional disturbance of a
- 13 child and the claims have on the cost of the coverage for group
- 14 health benefit plans.
- 15 (d) Not later than August 1, 2012, the department shall
- 16 submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 17 house of representatives, and the appropriate standing committees
- 18 of the legislature a report regarding the results of the study
- 19 required by Subsection (c), together with any recommendations for
- 20 legislation.
- (e) This subsection and Subsections (c) and (d) expire
- 22 <u>September 1, 2013.</u>
- SECTION 4. Section 1355.054(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 25 (a) Benefits of coverage provided under this subchapter may
- 26 be used only in a situation in which:
- 27 (1) the covered individual has a serious mental

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- 1 illness or serious emotional disturbance of a child that requires
- 2 confinement of the individual in a hospital unless treatment is
- 3 available through a residential treatment center for children and
- 4 adolescents or a crisis stabilization unit; and
- 5 (2) the covered individual's mental illness $\underline{\text{or}}$
- 6 emotional disturbance:
- 7 (A) substantially impairs the individual's
- 8 thought, perception of reality, emotional process, or judgment; or
- 9 (B) as manifested by the individual's recent
- 10 disturbed behavior, grossly impairs the individual's behavior.
- 11 SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a group health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for
- 13 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2012. A group health
- 14 benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 15 before January 1, 2012, is governed by the law as it existed
- 16 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
