- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 545, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 545.309 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 545.309. IDLING BUS DIESEL ENGINE AT SCHOOL OR IN
- 8 SCHOOL CROSSING ZONE PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "idling"
- 9 means allowing an engine to run while the motor vehicle is not
- 10 engaged in forward or reverse motion.
- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), the operator of a
- 12 school bus equipped with a diesel engine may not allow the idling of
- 13 the bus engine while the bus is parked at a school or in a school
- 14 crossing zone.

- (c) Subsection (b) does not prohibit the idling of a school
- 16 bus diesel engine:
- 17 (1) for the minimum time necessary to operate the bus
- 18 before departure, provided that the engine is turned off when a
- 19 student is embarking or disembarking; or
- 20 (2) as necessary to accommodate the physical needs of
- 21 a student who receives special education services, regardless of
- 22 whether students are embarking or disembarking.
- 23 (d) A local authority may enforce this section, including on
- 24 school property.
