A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to training for members of governing boards of public 3 junior college districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 61.084, Education Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 7 follows:

(a) The board by rule shall establish a training program for 8 9 members of the governing boards of institutions of higher education. Each member of a governing board of an institution of 10 11 higher education [the members of which are appointed] shall attend, 12 during the member's first two years of service as a member of a governing board of an institution of higher education, at least one 13 14 training program under this section. [A member of a governing board of an institution of higher education the members of which are 15 elected may attend a training program conducted under this 16 17 section.] A member of a governing board who is required to attend a training program under this section may[, but need not,] attend 18 additional training programs under this section. 19

20 (e) In addition to the content of the instruction at a 21 training program required under Subsection (d), topics covered by 22 the training program for members of a governing board of a public 23 junior college district must include information about best 24 practices in campus financial management, financial ratio

1 analysis, and case studies using financial indicators.
