- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 ARTICLE 1. TEXAS PROBATE CODE
- 7 SECTION 1.01. Chapter I, Texas Probate Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 11B to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 11B. EXEMPTION FROM PROBATE FEES FOR ESTATES OF
- 10 CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS, AND OTHERS.
- 11 (a) In this section:
- 12 (1) "Eligible decedent" means an individual listed in
- 13 <u>Section 615.003</u>, <u>Government Code</u>.
- 14 (2) "Line of duty" and "personal injury" have the
- 15 meanings assigned by Section 615.021(e), Government Code.
- 16 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a court may
- 17 not charge, or collect from, the estate of an eligible decedent any
- 18 of the following fees if the decedent died as a result of a personal
- 19 injury sustained in the line of duty in the individual's position as
- 20 <u>described by Section 615.003, Government Code:</u>
- 21 (1) a fee for or associated with the filing of the
- 22 <u>decedent's will for probate; and</u>
- 23 (2) a fee for any service rendered by the court
- 24 regarding the administration of the decedent's estate.

- 1 SECTION 1.02. The changes in law made by this article apply
- 2 only to the estate of a decedent who dies on or after the effective
- 3 date of this Act. The estate of a decedent who dies before the
- 4 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 5 date of the decedent's death, and the former law is continued in
- 6 effect for that purpose.
- 7 ARTICLE 2. ESTATES CODE
- 8 SECTION 2.01. Subchapter B, Chapter 53, Estates Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 53.054 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 53.054. EXEMPTION FROM PROBATE FEES FOR ESTATES OF
- 11 CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS, FIREFIGHTERS, AND OTHERS.
- 12 (a) In this section:
- 13 (1) "Eligible decedent" means an individual listed in
- 14 Section 615.003, Government Code.
- 15 (2) "Line of duty" and "personal injury" have the

- 2 ARTICLE 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 3 SECTION 3.01. Except as otherwise provided by this Act,
- 4 this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
