- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 572.062 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 572.062. FORMER LEGISLATOR: LOBBYING RESTRICTED;
- 8 CRIMINAL OFFENSE. (a) A former member of the legislature may not,
- 9 before the last day of the first regular session to convene after
- 10 the date the person ceases to be a member, engage in activities that
- 11 require registration under Chapter 305.
- 12 <u>(b) A former member who violates this section commits an</u>
- 13 offense. An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 572.062, Government Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, applies only to a member of the legislature who ceases to
- 16 be a member on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
