## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 9(a) and (c), Chapter 197, Acts of the
- 7 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963, are amended to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) The District shall hold an election in the District to
- 10 elect the appropriate number of port commissioners as required to
- 11 maintain a full Board of Port Commissioners on the uniform election
- 12 <u>date in [first Saturday of</u>] May in each odd-numbered year [at which
- 13 time there shall be elected five (5) Port Commissioners].
- 14 (c) Port [Except as provided by Subsection (d) of this
- 15 section, the] commissioners serve staggered six-year [four-year]
- 16 terms.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) A port commissioner who on the effective
- 18 date of this Act serves on the Board of Port Commissioners of the
- 19 Port of Port Arthur Navigation District of Jefferson County shall
- 20 continue in office until a successor is elected and qualified.
- 21 (b) Port commissioners of the Port of Port Arthur Navigation
- 22 District of Jefferson County shall serve six-year terms of office
- 23 beginning with terms of port commissioners elected at the election
- 24 held in 2013, in accordance with Sections 9(a) and (c), Chapter 197,

- 3 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 4 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 5 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 6 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 7 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 8 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 9 Government Code.
- 10 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 11 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 12 Environmental Quality.
- 13 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 14 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 15 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 16 representatives within the required time.
- 17 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 18 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 19 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 20 and accomplished.
- 21 SECTION 4. Except as provided by Section 2(b) of this Act,
- 22 this Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of
- 23 two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by
- 24 Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not
- 25 receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes
- 26 effect September 1, 2011.
