- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.006, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as

- 8 (a) The registrar may appoint one or more deputy registrars
- 9 to assist in the registration of voters, subject to Subsection (e).
- (e) To be eligible for appointment as a regular deputy
- 11 registrar under this section, a person must be a registered voter.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 13.031(d), Election Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (d) To be eligible for appointment as a volunteer deputy
- 15 registrar, a person must:
- 16 (1) be 18 years of age or older; [and]
- 17 (2) not have been finally convicted of a felony or, if
- 18 so convicted, must have:
- 19 (A) fully discharged the person's sentence,
- 20 including any term of incarceration, parole, or supervision, or
- 21 completed a period of probation ordered by any court; or
- 22 (B) been pardoned or otherwise released from the
- 23 resulting disability to vote; and
- 24 (3) be a registered voter.

- 1 SECTION 3. The appointment of a person serving as a regular
- 2 deputy registrar or volunteer deputy registrar who does not meet
- 3 the eligibility requirements of Section 12.006 or 13.031, Election
- 4 Code, as amended by this Act, expires on the effective date of this
- 5 Act. The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures necessary
- 6 to implement this section.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
