A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to state actions necessary to maximize federal funding for
- 3 certain transportation projects and activities in this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 2.133, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 7 (c) A report under Subsection (b) must also include the race
- 8 or ethnicity of each passenger in the motor vehicle, as stated by
- 9 the passenger or, if the passenger does not state the person's race
- 10 or ethnicity, as determined by the officer to the best of the
- 11 officer's ability.
- SECTION 2. Section 201.601, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 14 (e) The plan must include a component that evaluates future
- 15 federal funding opportunities for all modes of transportation and
- 16 identifies actions necessary to maximize the total amount of
- 17 federal funds received in the future for transportation
- 18 improvements in this state.
- 19 SECTION 3. Subchapter H, Chapter 201, Transportation Code,
- 20 is amended by adding Section 201.622 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 201.622. COOPERATION WITH LOCAL PLANNING ENTITIES TO
- 22 MAXIMIZE FEDERAL FUNDING FOR PROJECTS. The department shall work
- 23 and plan with local transportation planning entities to maximize
- 24 the amount of federal funding awarded for projects in this state by

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- 1 identifying and pursuing projects that are eligible for federal
- 2 grant programs, including the scenic byways program.
- 3 SECTION 4. The heading to Chapter 645, Transportation Code,
- 4 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 CHAPTER 645. [SINGLE STATE] REGISTRATION FOR OPERATION IN MULTIPLE
- 6 STATES
- 7 SECTION 5. Chapter 645, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 645.005 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 645.005. UNIFORM HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION.
- 10 The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles by rule shall establish,
- 11 implement, and administer the terms of the uniform program for
- 12 <u>hazardous materials transportation registration and permitting</u>
- 13 <u>developed</u> by the Alliance for Uniform Hazmat Transportation
- 14 Procedures under 49 U.S.C. Section 5119.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
