Section 271.9051(b), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) In purchasing under this title any real property, personal property that is not affixed to real property, or 8 9 services, if a municipality receives one or more competitive sealed bids from a bidder whose principal place of business is in the 10 municipality and whose bid is within five percent of the lowest bid 11 12 price received by the municipality from a bidder who is not a resident of the municipality, the municipality may enter into a 13 contract for construction services in an amount [an expenditure] of 14 less than \$100,000 or a contract for other purchases in an amount of 15 16 less than \$500,000 with: (1) the lowest bidder; or 17 18 (2) the bidder whose principal place of business is in the municipality if the governing body of the municipality 19 determines, in writing, that the local bidder offers the 20 21 municipality the best combination of contract price and additional economic development opportunities for the municipality created by 22

the contract award, including the employment of residents of the

municipality and increased tax revenues to the municipality.

1 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 2 to a contract for which a request for bids is first published or 3 distributed on or after the effective date of this Act.
